

Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS) Thailand, 2009

GATS is the global standard for systematically monitoring adult tobacco use (smoking and smokeless) and tracking key tobacco control indicators. GATS is a nationally representative survey, using a consistent and standard protocol across 14 countries. These countries are Thailand, India, Bangladesh, Viet Nam, China, Phillippines, Maxico, Poland, Uruguay, Brasil, Egypt, Turkey, the Russian Federation, and Ukraine. Thailand is among the first of 14 GATS countries to complete the data analysis and publish the survey findings.
